



DOUBLE STRIPES KIMONO

MATERIALS

3 Skeins Papatya Batik Timberland (size M/L)
Crochet Hook 5mm
US-terms

WAY OF WORK

Row 1: We have cast on this Kimono Double Crochet.

You cast on 161 Double Crochet.

If you can't, you can cast on with chainstitches 160 + 3(count as first dc), start in the fourth chainstitch and crochet 160 dc.

If you wish a bigger size cast on 15 chainstitches more.

note: After each row turn your work and crochet on the other side. Each row begins with 3 chainstitches, they always make the first dc of the row.

BORDER

Row 2: Start with 3 ch, *reliefstitch front, reliefstitch back, repeat from* till the end of the row. End with a dc on the last stitch, this is no Reliefstitch.

Row 3 + 4: Start with 3 ch., crochet the reliefstitch do as they occur. Did you the stitch in the last row in the back than you do the stitch in the back again. Did you crochet the stitch in the front than you do the stitch in the front again. End with a dc on the last stitch.

Row 5: Start with 3 ch., crochet in each stitch a dc (161 stiches in the row).

PATTERN (repeating 7 rows)

Row 6: 3 ch, *1 ch skip 1 st., 1 dc, repeat from* till the end of the row.

Row 7: 3 ch, 1 dc in each stich (around the ch and on the dc)

Row 8: 3 ch, 2 dc, 1 ch. skip 2 st., 1 dc-3ch-1dc in next st. *1ch skip 4 st., 1 dc-3ch-1dc in next st* Repeat from * _* until the're 5 st. left. Than 1 ch, skip 2 st. 3 dc.

DOUBLE STRIPES KIMONO

Row 9: 3 ch, 2 dc, *5 dc in the space of the 3ch., repeat from*, till the end of the row than 3 dc in the ast 3 st.


Row 10: 3ch, 1 dc in each st. (161 st. in the row)

Row 11: 3ch *1 ch, skip 1 st., 1 dc, repeat from* till the end of the row.

Row 12: 3ch., 1 dc in each st. (round the ch en on the dc.)

Repeat row 6 incl. 12 again 3x. The first part of the Kimono is finished.

The next part we make 2x. This are the sleeves and the top-part of the back en frontparts. (see the drawing, the arrows gives the directon to chrochet.



Row 1: Cast on 81 dc or 80 + 3 ch (counts as first dc), start in the 4th st, 80 dc.

BORDER

row 2: 3 ch, *relief dc front, relief dc back, repeat from* till the end of the row. End with a dc on the last st.

DOUBLE STRIPES KIMONO

- Rw 3+4: 3 ch, crochet de reliëf dc as they occur. Did you in the last row de reliëf dc back than you do it now on the back too. Did you the Reliëf dc in the front than you do it now in the front too.
- Row 5: 3 ch in each st. 1 dc. (81 dc in the row)
- Row 6: 3 ch *1ch., skip 1 st., 1 dc, repeat from*, till the end of the row.
- Row 7: 3 ch, 1 dc in each st. (around every ch and on every dc.)
- Row 8: 3 ch, 2 dc, 1 ch., skip 2 st., 1 dc - 3 ch -1 dc in next st. *1 ch., skip 4 st., 1 dc - 3 ch - 1 dc in next st* repeat from*_* til 3 st. to the end, on the last 3 st. 3 dc.
- Row 9: 3 ch, 2 dc, *5 dc around the 3 ch, repeat from* till the're are 3 st on the end of the row, 3 dc in last st.
- Row 10: 3 ch, dc in every st. (81 st. in the row)
- Row 11: 3 ch, *1 ch., skip 1 st., 1 dc, repeat from* till the end of the row.
- Row 12: 3 ch, 1 dc in every st. (around the ch and on every dc)

Repeat row 6 incl. 12 again 2x.

SEPERATE (Now we go to seperate to create the neck)

- Row 1: 3 ch, *1 ch., skip 1 st., 1 dc, repeat from*
repeat 19x (41 st.)
- Row 2: 3 ch, 1 dc in every st. (around ch and on the dc) (41 dc)
- Row 3: 3, ch, 2 dc, 1 ch., skip 2 st., 1 dc -3 ch - 1 dc in the next st. *1 ch., skip 4 st., 1 dc - 3 ch - 1 dc in the next st.* repeat from *_* till de last 5 st. , 1 ch, skip 2 st. 3 dc.
- Row 4: 3 ch, 2 dc, *5 dc around the 3 ch, repeat from* till the end of the row 3 dc on the last 3 st.
- Row 5: 3 ch, in every st. 1 dc. (41 dc in this row)
- Row 6: 3 ch, *1 ch. skip 1 st., 1 dc, repeat from*, till the end of the row.
- Row 7: 3 ch, 1 dc in every st. (around the ch en on the dc.)

DOUBLE STRIPES KIMONO

Insert the yarn in the 41th st. where you began to separate (the end of the first separation)

Repeat the part from row 1 till row 7 of the separation.

TO SEW THE PARTS TOGETHER

Mark the first (big) part 1 with a stitchmarker in the middle.


Fold the sides to the middle till the stitchmarker.

Double the little part (part 2) with the separation above.

Put it above Part 1 and be careful that the point of the hook lies in close contact with the point of hook of part 1. Repeat this with the other Part 2, of course in reflection. We've sew the parts

together for a flat result but of course you can crochet the parts together.

If you use stitchmarkers you can put the parts with more stitchmarkers together so the sewing become easier. To sew the frontparts together, to begin from the hookpoint of part 1 and sew in the direction of the border of the sleeve. Sew the frontpart until row 12 count from the border of the sleeve together. To sew the other side it is the same from the stitchmarker on the back. Sew in direction of the border of the sleeve. Sew de parts (border until row 12) of the sleeves together. Repeat this with the other sleeve and sew on the back both parts 2 together.



For a nice finishing we've crochet a row hdc from the border below the Kimono up to the collar and neck and back down to the other side of the border below.

Your Double stripes Kimono is finished!
